Compatible with the GasAlertClip Extreme, GasAlert Extreme, GasAlertMax XT, GasAlertMicroClip, GasAlertMicro and GasAlertMicro 5 Series, the MicroDock II requires no computer and provides simultaneous management of up to ten modules.
